## **Victor Breu Leaves «Finanz und Wirtschaft»**

Zurich, 30 October 2006 — Victor Breu steps down as Editor in Chief of «Finanz und Wirtschaft» by the end of October. Breu is leaving the company for personal reasons and of his own choice.

Victor Breu, 49, who has led editorship since 2005, contributed substantially to the positive development of «Finanz und Wirtschaft». The investor newspaper «Finanz und Wirtschaft» has been able to successfully develop and position itself as a qualitatively high standing medium. The Board of Directors and management thank Victor Breu for his work as Editor in Chief and wish him all the best for his personal future.

Until a decision is made over the successor, deputy chief editor, Peter Schuppli, and publishing head, Martin Coninx, will take over management of «Finanz und Wirtschaft» together. Schuppli (57), who has been engaged since 30 years for «Finanz und Wirtschaft» and until now led the Swiss department, will primarily take care of editorial concerns. Martin Coninx (35) is further responsible for the publishing house activities of the Finanz und Wirtschaft AG.
